TEAM INFO: Athletic training services will be available on site provided by Winona Health. In case of inclement weather teams will be let into the school. **Please do not allow cleats in the building.** All gyms will provide areas for teams with the commons providing shelter for spectators. **Concessions will be available for purchase.** Our training room is located adjacent to the high school locker rooms. Ice can be obtained from this room or from the on-site trainer. Trophies for tournament champions will be given for both events. Baseball tournament champion will be decided on tie breakers as follows - 1. best record, 2. least runs allowed, and 3. most runs scored.

SPECTATOR INFO: Spectators are asked to arrive no earlier than 9:30 AM. Please follow directions as to wear to park and get tickets (see attached map). Concessions will be available for purchase at both complexes. Please monitor the activities of your children during the contests. Unsupervised children will be required to return to where their parents are seated. Restrooms are located throughout the school facility and in portable units at all complexes. WIAA spectator guidelines apply.
